1. **Formal Portrait:** Posed, well lit subject. Produce 3 shots of your own with solid balance (use rule of thirds), even lighting, good focus with the manual settings. Your shots should include at least one indoor and one outdoor image. Crop to 8 x 10 vertical @ 300dpi. Retouch skin, eyes & teeth for all 3, outdoor lighting for the exterior shots. **Post to blog w/ questions.**

3. What was the hardest part of this process?

Take many shots, you will be graded on: value in the overall photo, composition & balance, Photoshop skill, and use of time.

Value	Photo shows a complete range of value from the whitest white to the darkest dark and every value in between.
