Photojournalism vs Artistic Photography (20 pts each)

Photojournalism: A type of journalism in which a news story is presented primarily through photographs with supplementary written copy.

Photojournalism as a "medium can be used in what are intended as interpretively neutral ways to document life as it is. It can also be a vehicle for political, social and personal statements. In many cases, the lines between objectivity and subjectivity, fact and attitude, are impossible to disentangle."

Photojournalism provides a more complex and fully human way of capturing, describing and explaining to others what words often fail to do. Photographs can evoke a range of human feelings -- dignity, integrity, shame, industry, integrity, pain, or joy -- far beyond verbal linguistic description.
