Advertising Design

You are going to make a Photoshop advertisement for something.

It could be a public service announcement (like anti-smoking or anti vaping, recycling, don't drink and drive, child poverty, etc.) or a product (like shoes, coca cola, perfume, make-up, etc.) - NO CELL PHONES!

Steps - NOT A GROUP PROJECT

- 1) Look at print ads in magazines and online ads for ideas for photography and good design with visual hierarchy.
- 2) Save photos or ads that you like that may inspire your work. Think about what ad you would like to make, and how you are going to accomplish it.
- 3) Talk to your teacher for approval on your idea.
- 4) You need to take the photographs and it needs to include a still life image, preferably with one of the class DSLRs, take many photos (10-20).
- 5) Add text a, then use photoshop to crop, adjust light and color, and add special effects and a logo. (logo may be sourced from the internet)

Setting up in Photoshop

Open up Photoshop. Click File>New Your settings should be the following:

Size: 8" x 10" either vertical or horizontal

Resolution: 150 pixels/inch Color Mode: RGB color

****Name your file using your first name and 'advertisement'. (example: Jessica_advertisement.psd)

Checklist for your work

- 1) Approval for your idea
- 2) should include some kind of selection use, manual or auto
- 3) played with colour
- 4) layers used
- 5) clone tool, added effect, or other manipulation
- 6) Use good/interesting, well crafted photographs
- 7) demonstrated good design (does it look good? is it interesting and creative?)
- 8) file is saved as a .PSD file, then .jpg
- 9) screen shot of info & more from the .psd file
- 10) post the .jpg & the screen shot & fill out the rubric & answer the questions.

Most importantly, your ad should be awesome!
