Photographing Water

- Rules:
1. NO WATER on the camera.
 2. NO HORSEPLAY around the equipment
 2. YOU set up your station and YOU clean up your station.
 3. Always treat the equipment in a professional manner.

Equipment:

Camera/s, Tripod/s, Spotlight/s, tracing paper, cardboard & wrapping paper to create backdrops, alligator clips, tape, bowls, jars, eyedroppers, water, plastic (or trays to lay down for spills), food coloring, and mirrors.

Procedure: Students will work in groups of 2-3 to shoot water. There are 4 stations that they will rotate through, all 4 with DSLR's .

Students will have 1 SD card for their group, and will shoot at the DSLR stations taking their card with them, then uploading. Each student will pick their favorite 6 shots (at least 1 per station) to post for 5pts each.
