Still Life Photography

Instructions:

Take 5 Still life shots. These will be shot on-site in the studio. BE CREATIVE!!! Think of your lighting, angle and background! Re-touch your image to enhance the mood with color adjustments, edge burning / vignetting, hue/saturation, levels, or another enhancement.

Image #1: Monochromatic (Monochromatic color schemes are derived from a single base hue and extended using its shades, tones and tints. Tints are achieved by adding white and shades and tones are achieved by adding a darker color, gray or black.)

Image #2: Warm Color (Colors that represent warmth or fire such as reds, oranges and yellows.)

Image #3: Cool Color (Colors that are associated with cold, such as Blue, Purple, and green).)

Image #4: Neutral color (Neutral colors such as tans, whites, blacks and grays)

Image #5: Thematic (Elements based around an element of art such as line, color, shape, etc. or a principle of design such as balance, variety, emphasis, etc.)

*For each image: crop and use the camera raw filter.

Questions (5 points):

- 1. What was your favorite image and why?
- 2. How is the lighting in your favorite image (direct, diffused, etc.)?
- 3. What worked well while photographing?
- 4. What would you have done differently?
- 5. What was the element or principle in your thematic image?
